SUMMARY OF THE TRAINING COURSE

All people from Germany, Italy, Slovakia, Czech Republic, France and Poland who are involved in **educational or social work** or who are interested in working in this field are invited to join our International Training Course in the east of Germany. We will creatively and collectively develop our knowledge and competences for ensuring a **more sustainable and fair world!**

The course will last from the 7th (arriving day) to the 13th (departure day) of **November**, and is open to people **over 18** who feel comfortable expressing themselves in **English**.



During the training course we will explore the concept of **global learning** in detail and see several applications of it. Participants will **learn how to design and implement an educational program** and explore different **topics** related to sustainability, human rights, world inequalities and existing solidary solutions to overcome those obstacles and prompt a better future for everybody worldwide.

At the same time, the course will be an opportunity to meet many other open-minded people from different European countries interested in educational work with whom to share good practices, create a support network and have a true **intercultural experience**.

The course will take place in a seminar house in Grillenburg, a village in the countryside **near Dresden** so we will have the occasion to enjoy the peace and the beauty of living surrounded by nature. The costs of the **accommodation and food** (sustainable of course!) will be completely covered and all the **travel expenses** from your country to the seminar place will be refunded (please choose a green travel solution, otherwise we won't be able to pay you back!). We just ask to the participants a small **donation** as a contribution for the realization of the course from 0 to 100€, from each one according to one's possibility, basing on a solidarity principle.

Participants will be able to travel light, they are only asked to bring comfortable clothes, bed sheets and a strong desire to embark on this exciting transformative learning experience!

AIM AND OBJECTIVES

Maybe some of you are wondering what exactly is **Global Learning or Global Citizenship Education**? In simple words, we see it as a **transformative educational concept that understands the world population as a global community and seeks to achieve social justice and equality for all**.

During the course we are going to exchange our perspectives and ideas about Global Learning methodologies and develop workshops on themes such as: natural resources exploitation, social injustice behind our lifestyle and solidary solutions regarding those global issues.

The training course will be as **participative** as possible, attendees will **learn by doing** most of the concepts and redirect the course of the training according to their interests and needs.

The first day there will be an introduction about the program and we will get to know each other and the surrounding nature also through a short excursion.

The second day of the training course, after a comprehensive introduction about the concept of Global Learning, the participants will be divided in 10 groups and will have to choose one method among those presented by the moderator.



Every team will be leading a workshops for the rest of the participants from Wednesday to Friday, with the exception of Friday morning when the workshop will take place in a local school. In this way everybody will gain educational skills of leading and moderating workshops about global issues, learning by doing about non-formal pedagogical methods. In addition, participants will gradually create a practical guide with the methods developed during the course. During the evenings there will be time for cultural exchanges and few more visual inputs and games.

They are open to looking beyond national borders and questioning topics critically. Participants must be respectful of each other and accept different opinions.

Travel costs



For the Intercultural night you should present something that could represent an aspect of your culture to show to the other participants. It could be a traditional food, or an object or music etc..
